### Kids Stay Here

Of the 140 children who stayed with us last year 70.8% were under the age of six years old.

## Who Stays Here in a Year?



Take a moment and think about this . . . Nova Vita has the capacity to house 33 women and children at any given time.

In the 2015-2016 fiscal year the average shelter occupancy was 89%.

## But we spent 90 days at 100% capacity and <u>76 days over capacity</u>.



Why is domestic violence a problem in Brantford?

Domestic violence is an issue in Brantford and Brant County and Nova Vita works to help those affected in as many ways as funding allows. A study determined that there are risk factors in Brantford that predispose individuals to be victims of domestic violence in Brantford and the County of Brant. For example:

• Living in a common law relationship increases the risk of violence in the home – Brantford has significantly more common law couples than surrounding communities or Ontario as a whole.

• Mental health status also has an impact on domestic violence – the percentage of people in Brantford and the County of Brant who self identify as having fair or poor mental health is higher than surrounding areas.

• Inadequate income is also a stressor that can lead to domestic violence – the median household income in Brantford and the County of Brant is significantly lower than in other southern Ontario cities.

• The violent crime rate in Brantford is higher than in surrounding communities and is higher than Ontario and Canadian averages.

## Time to Think Differently

#### Myth:

If it was that bad, they would just leave.

#### Reality:

A victim may be reluctant to leave the relationship for a complex set of reasons including shame, fear of being unable to support herself and the family, degraded self-esteem after years of emotional abuse, concern about leaving pets, feeling responsible for the abuse, and/or feelings of love or concern for her abuser. Other reasons may include: being disabled, unaware of outside supports, unable to speak English, new to the country, and/or fear of being deported.

#### Myth:

Perpetrators of domestic violence are never loving partners.

#### Reality:

In many abusive relationships, there is an escalating pattern of abuse. When not in a violent episode, victims of domestic violence often describe their partners as loving and sensitive, thus making it very difficult for abused partners to leave an abusive relationship.
